



## LEBANESE WINE LIST

Lebanon is among the oldest sites of wine production in the world. The Phoenicians of its coastal strip were instrumental in spreading wine and viticulture throughout the Mediterranean in ancient times. Despite the many conflicts of the region, the country has an annual production of about 3.6 million bottles of wine.

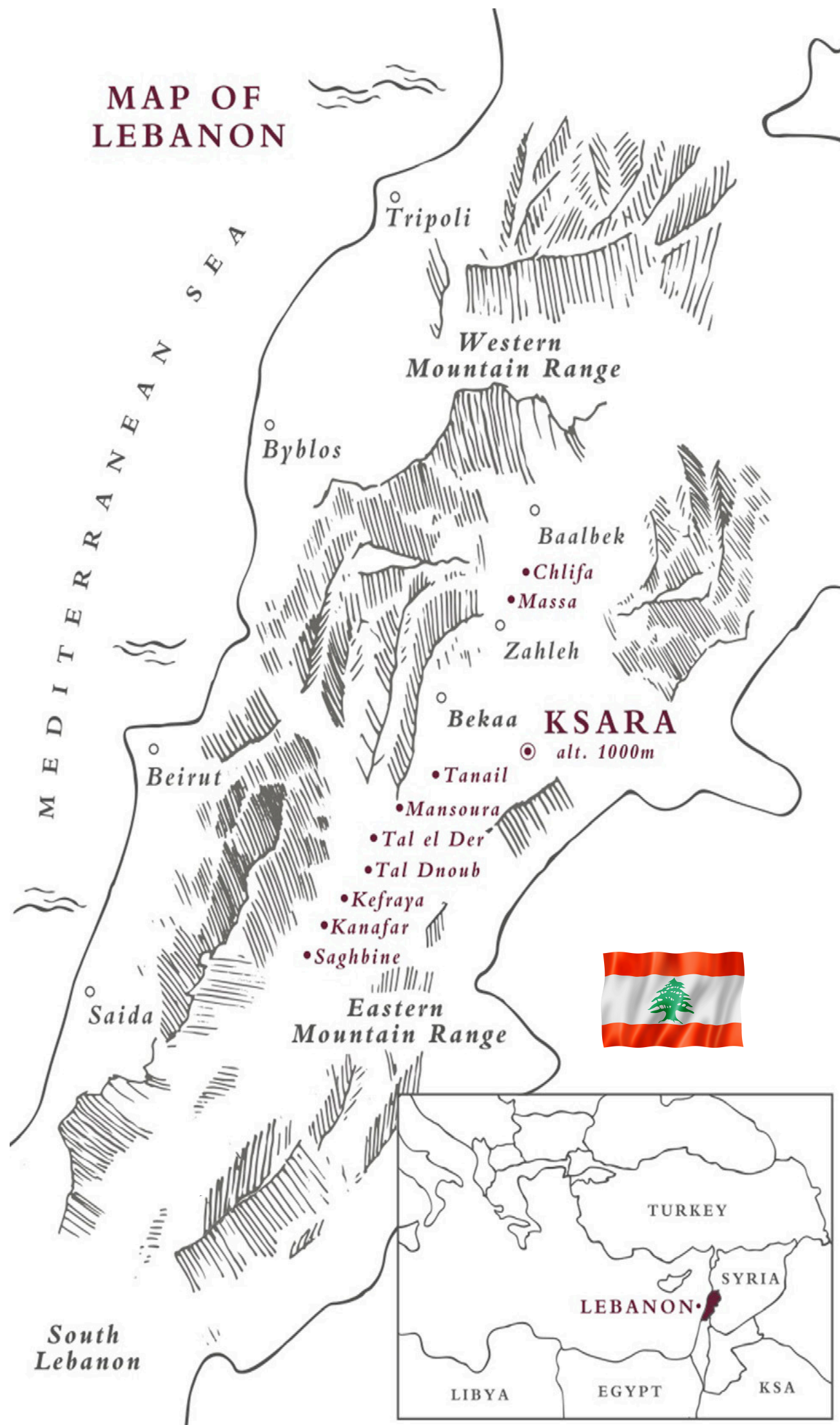
Bekaa Valley is located at an average altitude of 1,000 meters. The Bekaa has a semi-continental climate. The winters are cold with moderate rainfall and the summers are hot and dry. The altitude means that the hot summer days are balanced by cool evenings with a temperature difference of around 15°C.

The vineyards also benefit from the land's own natural water table, which is situated between two snow-capped mountain ranges

Pesticides and herbicides are not used, so the grapes are grown almost organically.



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## WHITE WINES

### BLANC DE L’OBSERVATOIRE CHATEAU KSARA

Grapes: Viognier, Muscat à petits grains, Sauvignon blanc, Chardonnay and Vermentino. With a nose of white flowers, Les Bretèches Blanc combines intense refreshing notes of exotic fruits and citrus on the palate.

## RED WINES

### LE PRIEURÉ CHATEAU KSARA

Grapes: Carignan, Cinsault, Mourvèdre and Caladoc  
Made with grapes that hark back to the Château Ksara’s origins and fermented in the concrete tanks built by the Jesuits, this medium-bodied, unoaked wine, which can be served slightly chilled, is filled with an exotic fruity aroma along with spicy and licorice notes and spice of the Bekaa Valley.

### CHÂTEAU BELLE VUE LA RENAISSANCE 2011

Merlot has the slight upper hand as La Renaissance 2011 presents its warming aromas of morello cherry and freshly-ground pepper. Rounded tannins are complemented by well-integrated oak, with leather and tobacco providing a masculine subtext. Ripe dark red fruits appear in the long finish-A hallmark of wines from our high- altitude terraces in the mountains overlooking the blue med.
